b) Purposes of the processing for which personal data are intended and their legal grounds

Your personal data will be processed:

(i) without your consent (Section 6 (b, c, f, of the GDPR), for the following purposes:

- comply with pre-contractual and contractual obligations arising from the execution of a supply or other service agreement offered by Metalcastello SpA;
- comply with the provisions of domestic or EU laws or regulations, or carry out an order of a judicial or supervisory Authority to which the Controller is subject;
- exercise the rights of the Controller, and specifically the defence of legal rights;

(ii) with your consent (Section 7 of the GDPR), for the following purposes:

- organization of events, meetings, congresses and seminars, including those designed for continuing professional education or promotion,
- various types of marketing activity, including the promotion of professional services, the distribution of materials of an informative and promotional nature, the sending of newsletters and publications.

The communication of data for the purposes under section (i) is mandatory. Lack of data and/or any express refusal to accept processing of such data will make it impossible for the Controller to comply with the mandate received or will involve a violation of requests by the relevant Authorities.

Communication of the data for the purposes under section (ii) above is optional, therefore you can opt not to give your consent, or to revoke it any time, at no cost.

c) Categories of personal data processed

The processing purposes set out in paragraph (c) above shall only concern personal data consisting of, for instance, name and surname, tax id. code, VAT registration number, address, work address, email or certified email (PEC) address, telephone and fax number, employer identification data, position held in the company, etc..

d) Categories of recipients of personal data

For the purposes set out under paragraph (c) above, section (i), your personal data can be disclosed to:

1. employees and collaborators of the Controller, in their capacity as data handlers,
2. third parties outsourcers on behalf of the Controller, in their capacity as data processors.
3. national or EU judicial or supervisory Authorities, governmental entities and agencies;

If you consent to the use of personal data for the purposes of paragraph (c), section (ii) above, such data may be disclosed to the persons indicated under points (1), (2), and (3) above.

e) Period for which the personal data will be stored

The personal data collected for the purposes set out in paragraph (c), subparagraph (i) above will be processed and stored for the whole term of the legal relationship, if any.

Starting from the end of said relationship, for any reason or cause, the data will be stored for the term of expiry provided by law.

Personal data collected for the purposes set out under paragraph (c), subparagraph (ii) above shall be processed and stored for the time necessary to comply with such purposes and however not beyond 2 years from the date of receiving your consent.

f) Exercisable rights

In compliance with the provisions of Chapter III, Section I, GDPR, you may exercise the rights therein indicated and in particular:

- **Right of access** - Obtain confirmation whether your data are processed or not and, if so, obtain information related, in particular, to: the purposes of such processing, the categories of the processed personal data, the storage period, the recipients to whom such data can be transferred (Section 15, GDPR),
- **Right to rectification** - Obtain, without undue delay, the rectification of any inaccurate personal data and have any incomplete personal data supplemented (Section 16, GDPR),
- **Right to erasure** - Obtain, without undue delay, the erasure of your personal data, in the cases provided for by the GDPR (Section 17, GDPR),
- **Right to restriction** - Obtain from the Joint Controllers the limitation to processing, in the cases provided for by the GDPR (Section 18, GDPR)
- **Right to data portability** - Receive your personal data as communicated to the Data Controllers in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and obtain the transmission of such data to another controller without any hindrance, where provided for by the GDPR (Section 20, GDPR)
- **Right to object** - Object to the processing of your personal data, unless the Joint Controllers have compelling legitimate grounds for the continuation of the processing (Section 21, GDPR)
- **Right to lodge a complaint with the Supervisory Authority** - Lodge a complaint to Autorità Garante per la protezione dei dati personali, Piazza di Montecitorio n. 121, 00186, Roma (RM).

You may exercise such rights by means of a request to be sent by email to the Data Privacy Officer certified email address above indicated.

g) Processing methods

Your personal data will be processed as indicated in section 4, n. 2), GDPR - whether or not by automated means – and precisely: collection, recording, organisation, structuring, update, storage, adaptation or modification, retrieval and analysis, consultation, use, disclosure by transmission, comparison, restriction, erasure or destruction.

In any event, the logical and physical security of the data and, in general, the confidentiality of the personal data processed, adopting all necessary technical and organisational measures appropriate to guarantee the data security.
